Waterboys in Japan



It's usually girls who like to have the same chances as boys in sports such as football, rugby and basketball. But sometimes things can change. A group of boys from Kawagoe

High School in Japan have made news. They have trained as synchronised swimmers, which is a sport that has always been more popular with girls than boys.

It started nearly twenty years ago when the school decided it wanted to get boys into synchronised swimming, too. Although synchronised swimmers have traditionally been girls, you have to be physically very strong to do it. These talented Japanese students now believe that things are changing in the world of synchronised swimming. 'We don't think it's weird to do synchronised swimming. We think it's cool. Of course, boys can do it,' said one of the competitors.

This unusual swimming team is now famous in Japan. Every year it performs in a festival and it attracts a lot of spectators. An incredible 20,000 people came to watch the swim team's performances at the school's annual festival. They are like film stars. In fact, the boys have caused so much interest that a film was made by director Yaguchi Shinobu. It won the best actor award and best musical score award at the Japan Academy Film Festival.

And since then more things have changed in Kawagoe. "As a historical town we have always attracted older tourists. Since the 'Waterboys' movie and TV shows fortunately more younger visitors — especially high school kids — come to visit the area," said Yoshiharu Hibiki. He is a member of a club in Kawagoe, which promotes tourism in the town.
